

Thirty-Third Annual HARROP AND RUTH FREEMAN PRIZE IN PEACE STUDIES

WHAT: Prize to encourage Cornell undergraduates to pursue work or study in fields related to peace studies and conflict resolution. Value in 2017 is \$2,500.

WHY: To recognize contributions of individuals working to promote peace and encourage continued work or education in the field of peace studies. Preference will be given to students who plan to work in peace-related organizations, but students who are going on to graduate work in the field are also eligible for consideration.

WHO: Graduating Cornell seniors are eligible to apply online:

- 1) Include a brief (200-500 words) statement of purpose;
- 2) Identify your advisor or a faculty member who knows your work well and they will be asked to submit a letter of recommendation for you in the online application;
- 3) Ask the Registrar to send an e-transcript for you to pacs@inaudi.cornell.edu
