

Interested in Funding for a Summer 2017 Internship?

Harrop and Ruth Freeman Fellowship

The Judith Reppy Institute for Peace and Conflict Studies will award one or more Harrop and Ruth Freeman Fellowships to encourage Cornell undergraduates to pursue summer work related to peace studies and conflict resolution in an otherwise unpaid position with a not-for-profit organization.

Eligibility: Current Cornell freshmen, sophomores, and juniors interested in funding for their summer 2017 internship.

Value: A stipend of \$1200 per month for up to 2 months.

Application Process:

- 1) Identify and secure a summer internship. Give us a copy of the documentation you received from the employer describing the details of your internship.
- 2) Apply online at <http://fundingapp.einaudi.cornell.edu>. Login with your Cornell ID and password. Submit a brief statement (200-500 words) about yourself and your summer opportunity, and describing how the internship would benefit you in reaching your long-term goals.
- 3) Ask an advisor or faculty member to supply a letter of recommendation. They will be prompted by the online system to upload their letter.
- 3) Send us an official Cornell transcript. You may request the Registrar to send an e-transcript to pacs@einaudi.cornell.edu.

Deadline: Submit your transcript and internship confirmation details to the Reppy Institute office and apply online by April 12, 2017.
